Who will take the survey?

Students in grades 3-12, families, teachers and staff members will participate in the survey. Once results are available, school leaders will receive support and resources to make sense of and act on the data in their schools.



What will the surveys measure?

The Effective Schools Framework survey will measure topics related to Essential Actions within the Levers of Strong School Leadership & Planning, Strategic Staffing, Positive School Culture, High Quality Instructional Materials, and Effective Instruction.



Which schools will participate in this initiative?

Schools who have applied for the Effective Schools Framework grant will participate in the survey as part of their Diagnostic Process. Schools may also opt-in to the Diagnostic for a fee, and participate in the survey.
